Pupils

- about 160 pupils with special emotional and social needs
- between 6 to 11 years
- need support in emotional and social development
- about 30 of them with ADS diagnosis (special classes)
- organised in 13 classes with 10 to 15 pupils each
- classes from first to fourth grade = primary school

Pedagogical concept

- Content-related standards of the regular primary school
- Objective of our school is to bring pupils back into regular schools
- ELDiB (developmental and educational form) as a diagnostic instrument and base for the individual education plans
- EPU can be translated as "developmental teaching"
- Teaching teams (two teachers at the same time in class)
- full-day school
