### Tuesday, 25.02.2020

The first day of the training program included:

- an artistic program offered by the children for marking the event
- visit the school and its facilities
- the creation of the Puzzle + All together by the Pano-painting technique, which brought together fragments of works by children from all partner schools,
- evaluating the changes made in each school regarding the improvement of "teacher-teacher" relationships
- presentation of new ways of strengthening the "teacher-pupil" relationships in guest schools.
  - Heinrich-Böll-Schule - kindergarten settings in entrance classes, cooking/eating together with pupils as a form of strengthening relationships, one to one activities, social games, trips/picnics together pupils and teachers
  - Janusz-Korczak-Schule - children's conferences / youth conferences, weekly meeting with all pupils, joint birthday parties for teachers and students each month, trips together , visits to pupils homes
  - 136 PS "Luben Karavelov" Introducing the "stimulus-response" approach to ensure a supportive learning and strengthening teacher-pupil relationships

### Wednesday, 26.02.2020

The day was dedicated to music therapy, as a means of strengthening the "teacher-pupil" relationships with children with special educational needs and beyond.

The guests participated in an activity of music therapy, followed by an interactive workshop, in which the principles, the modalities of the approach, the methodological aspects of the therapy were presented. (trainer Herman Szabolcs , special education teacher)

The next activity was a joint workshop to create various percussion instruments who can be used during music therapy session.

The day ended with an evaluation session.



**Thursday, 27.02.2020**

The day was dedicated to sensory swimming as a way to strengthen pupil/teacher relationships .

The first part of the activity was dedicated to familiarizing the partners with theoretical notions about this innovative method and the objectives pursued: improving the child-therapist / teacher relationship, developing trust in teacher/therapist , self-confidence, motor developing, orienting in a different environment (water), neurosensory stimulation. In the second part of the day, the guests watched a demonstrative sensory swimming activity. For the smooth running of the activity carried out at the Hotel Maxim Oradea pool, the teachers were supported by the volunteer students from the Faculty of Geography, Tourism and Sport, the Department of Physical Education, Sport and Physical therapy at the University of Oradea.

Meeting for discussing

1. How to create a puzzle for pupils/teachers use – Marjia Bulgaria
2. Discussing the ways to strengthen the teacher-child relationship that will be taken over by each country. Redefining the objectives for the next period (compare Results /Agreements)

At the end of the day, the evaluation activity took place through the game “I think, I feel , I kick” where the guests were invited to present their opinions, ideas, appreciations about the LTT organisation. All the impressions were positive. Thank You ! 😊

## Results / Agreements about ongoing work

### The ways to strengthen the teacher-child relationship that will be taken over by each country:

- CSEI Cristal will implement joint trips/picnic , joint teacher-pupil birthday celebrations, work-shops of cooking together teachers and pupils
- 136 PS "Luben Karavelov" will implement music therapy for children with Down syndrome and autism in school, will use volunteers from local university, future teachers in order to make them more open to teach for roma children, a joint teacher-pupil workshop of creating unconventional music instruments and strengthen pupil-teacher relationship
- Heinrich-Böll-Schule will also implement music as a way to strengthen pupil-teacher relationship in a joint creative work-shop including also drama, communication games etc. They try to prove their activities with help of the "stimulus-response-theory"
- Janusz-Korczak-Schule will apply joint meals/breakfast together in primary classes, the one to one discussions teacher-pupil, a survey in school to collect ideas from children and staff about ways to improve relationships
