and 4 primary classes



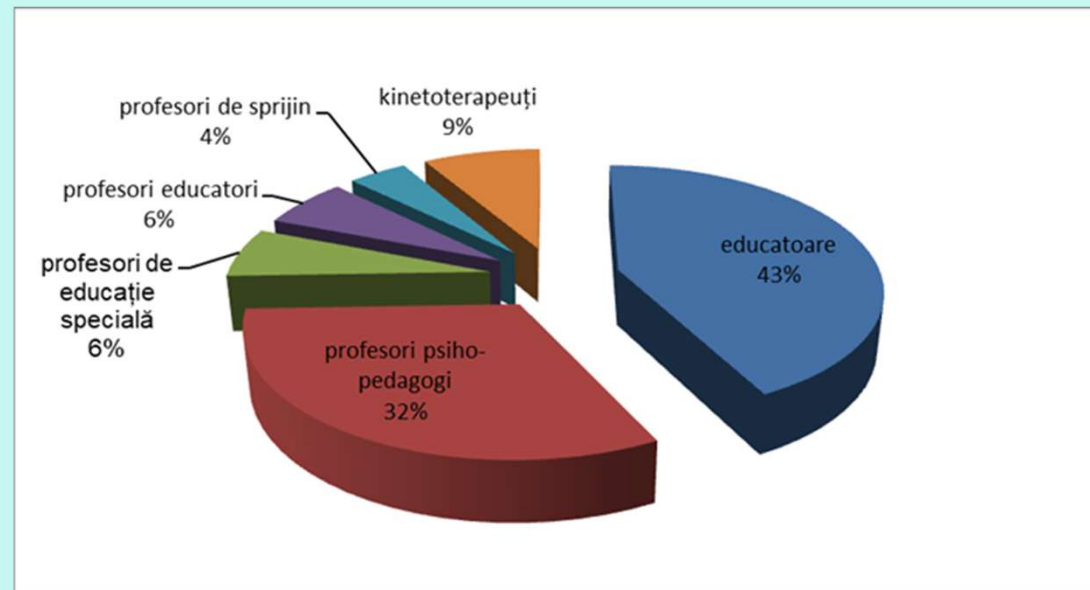
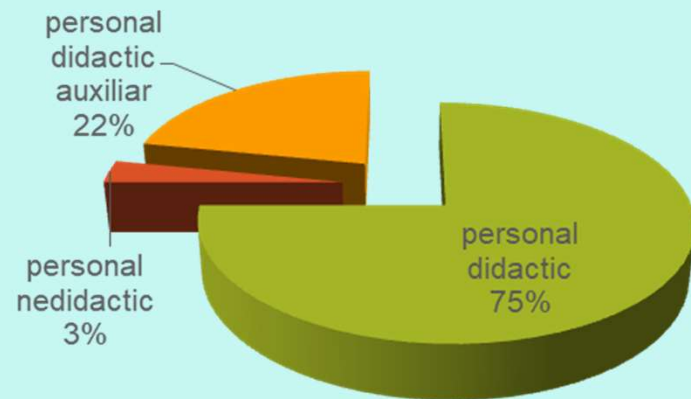
We have in our school 104 children with various disabilities :
visually impaired, hearing impaired, MSI, mental, autism, motor etc .



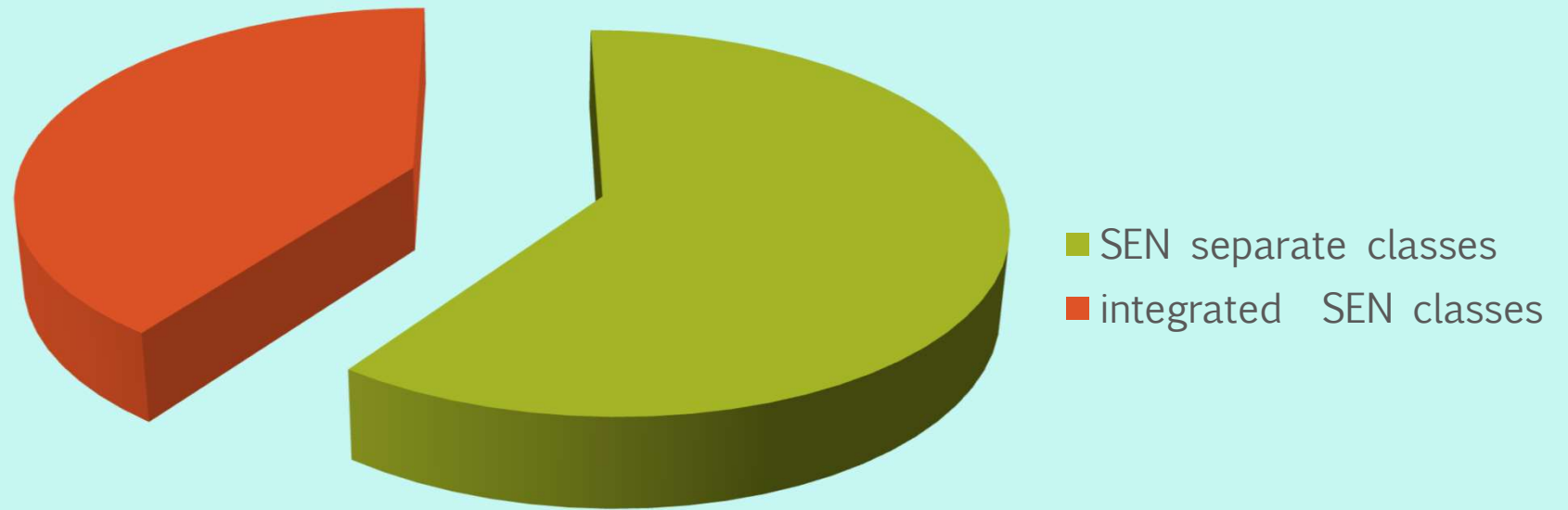

Our school organizes and carries out the educational and rehabilitation process through specific pedagogical approaches/therapies.

The mission of CSEI Cristal Oradea is to achieve a quality, educational approach, adapted, in a secure environment aimed at integrating children with special needs into the community and raising awareness of their needs.





Our *main objectives* are:

- *the early detection and early intervention for SEN children with various disabilities;
- *the implementation of specific therapies/pedagogical approaches for children with disabilities within our institution,
- *the evaluation, diagnosis and follow-up of the school evolution of SEN children within the multidisciplinary teams
- *stimulating children's abilities to get in touch with others and discover their own identity in order to facilitate social inclusion etc.

During the last years more and more children with mild, severe, associated and profound disabilities come to our school.

Together with the other partners in the project we identified the same need to review the curricula and to learn from each other new therapies, methods and pedagogical approaches in order to ensure the development of children with disabilities by capitalizing on their full potential
