
Luben Karavelov

Luben Karavelov is a Bulgarian poet, writer, encyclopedist, journalist, ethnographer and a national hero, a fighter for Bulgaria's liberation from Ottoman rule.

He contributes significantly to the development of public thought in Bulgaria during the Renaissancewrites:

- -bibliographical works,
- -articles on Bulgarian literature,
- -culture, lexicography,
- -political history,
- -numismatics.

Karavelov participated in the National revolution as a member and chairman of the Bulgarian Revolutionary Central Committee (BRC) in Bucharest, Romania in the early 1970s.

OUR SHCOOL organization

- Two stages of education elementary and upper secondary, 393 students;
 one-shift training regime;
- Training of children from preparatory groups 2 groups 5 and 6-year-old children - 45 children, half-day organization;
- Full day organization of the school day I VI class 125 students;
- Computer training from II VII class.
- Resource support for children with special needs 24 students, 2 classrooms, 2 resource teachers, psychologist, speech therapist; accessible architectural environment;
- A school curriculum tailored to the needs of the students;
- Independent form of training;
- Transportation to and from school for 164 Roma students;
- Free snacks provided for the preparatory groups and students from I IV class, fruits from the School Fruit program and dairy products under
 the program "Cup of warm milk" of the State Fund Agriculture;
- Modernized and attractive material base;
- Qualified teachers to work in a multi-ethnic environment.

Why do we do it?

• Most of our pupils are from ethnic minorities - Roma. So main priorities in our work are: successful integration of students and their motivation for inclusion in the educational process, also to make them want to reach a hi level in their education.

Activities performed by mediators

Intermediary between teacher and Roma children or students with the aim of integrating them into school and society and providing equal opportunities for education and socialization.





Main functions of mediators

- Promotes mutual knowledge of children and students of different ethnic backgrounds;
- Assists leadership and teachers in interacting with parents;
- Assists in attracting children to go to school;
- Participates in the educational process and extracurricular activities under the guidance of the teacher and at his / her discretion;
- Accompanies children on organized transportation to and from school, responsible for protecting the lives and health of students;
- Contributes to the formation of positive attitudes towards teaching as a value and respect for the difference and individuality of the individual.

Policy Implementation Measures

Provision of additional funding for activities for early school drop-out of students under National programs and projects

- Success Support Project funded by the European Social Fund
- **❖** A program to reduce absenteeism and early school leavers;
- **Early Warning System "Personal profile of a child at risk of dropping out";**
- Register of students at risk;
- **❖** Introduced individual correction program for the student at risk;
- **❖** Individual support for students who are at risk of dropping out through additional training in subjects to overcome learning difficulties;

- ❖Raising the level of student self-government "Peers help peers", inclusion of "mentor students" to improve relationships and build a tolerant environment;
- ❖Use of interactive and innovative teaching methods to activate students;
- **❖Assistance with materials and teaching aids** for children and students at risk of dropping out;
- ❖Provide rewards for students who have shown higher learning outcomes;
- **❖**Attendance at cultural events, excursions, holidays;
- Increasing the capacity of parents "School for parents"
