Tuesday, 03.05.2022

1. Music and dance presentation

Presentation of several parent-teacher-activities such as common gardening activities and painting the school fence

e) The Dales School

Presentation of school programme-aspects which touches work on teacher-parent-relationships; creating Big-Hug-presents for parents

4. Workshop

Wednesday, 04.05.2022

1. **National Symposium with international participation Education for the future 2022 (Romania)**

The project participated to the National Symposium in Romania (online) and presented their working structure and their temporary results to the local school authority and other colleagues from all over Europe who are involved in several Erasmus projects.

All participants have discussed the touching points between other relationship-aspects and the aspect of community within the activities they have developed and offered so far during the project. As an important result of their so far project work they resumed that working on each single aspect of relationship will strengthen the school community automatically because community only can arise through a solid network of strong, well working relationships.

2. **Planning the final brochure of the project**

All participants have discussed layout, design, content and the way of using the brochure for dissemination of the project ideas, activities and results.

3. **Discussion about the evaluation of the project**

All participants have discussed about the type of evaluation and important aspects which should be included into the evaluation. The group has developed an evaluation questionnaire which will be discussed and filled by the participating staff of each school.

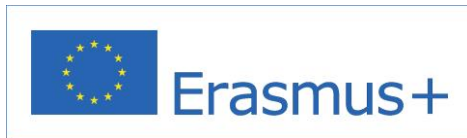
- All schools will fill the evaluation questionnaire (evaluation of the whole project) and send it to Thomas as PDF- file. Thomas will upload them on the blog.
